# UPI transaction volumes cross 20-b mark in August

**ON THE RISE.** About 645 m transactions were conducted daily

In a first, Unified Payments Interface (UPI) transaction volume breached the 20 billion mark in August 2025, according to National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) data.

A total of 20.01 billion transactions, amounting to ₹24.85 lakh crore, were registered in August.

Transaction volume rose 34 per cent on a year-on-year (y-o-y) basis, while UPI transaction value was up 21 per cent y-o-y in August.

On an average, 645 million UPI transactions were conducted daily in August.

"A 34 per cent y-o-y surge and steady month-on-month growth show that while digital payments may have started as an urban trend, they are now rapidly catching on in rural India and becoming a way of life for millions," said Dip Modi, CEO, Spice Money.

In July, 19.47 billion transactions, amounting to ₹25.08 lakh crore, were conducted using UPI.

Further, in July, most number of UPI transactions were conducted to pay for groceries, restaurants, mobile network bill, and bills at service stations, gaming apps, among others.

According to the data, over 3 billion UPI transactions amounting to ₹64,882 crore were conducted at groceries and supermarkets in July.

As many as 1.22 billion UPI transactions were executed at fast food restaur-

ants, while 1.15 billion transactions were conducted at eating joints and restaurants in July.

**MAHARASHTRA LEADS** Value wise, most users chose UPI to pay for their loans, credit card and 'buy now, pay later' bills.

Maharashtra topped the list of most UPI users in the country in July, while Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh ranked second and third in the list, respectively.

## CAD slips into deficit in Q1 FY26 from surplus in Q4 FY25

India's current account deficit (CAD) slipped in the first quarter (Q1 FY26) from a surplus recorded in the preceding quarter (Q4 FY25). However, it narrowed in the reporting quarter as against the year-ago quarter.

CAD is a measure of a country's trade where the value of goods and services it imports exceeds the value of the products it exports.

**FPI INFLOWS DRAG CAD** The current account balance in Q1 recorded a deficit of 0.2 per cent of GDP (surplus of 1.3 per cent of the GDP in Q4 of FY25).

CAD narrowed in the re-

porting quarter, against 0.9 per cent in the year ago period, primarily due to a rise in net services receipts, remittances, and inflows on account of foreign portfolio investment (FPI) and external commercial borrowings (ECBs).

In absolute terms, the CAD was at \$2.4 billion (\$8.6 billion). The country had recorded a current account surplus of \$13.5 billion in Q4 FY25. Aditi Nayar, Chief Economist, ICRA, said, "While India's current account expectedly reverted to a deficit in Q1, the extent of the same was considerably lower than our projection (\$7 billion) — at just \$2.4 billion or 0.2 per cent of GDP."

Nayar noted that the surprise was largely driven by



larger-than-anticipated remittances, which surged by 18 per cent on a y-o-y basis in the quarter.

"This augurs well, given the uncertainty that lies ahead given the recent tariff-related developments. Considering that 50-60 per cent of India's exports to the US (total merchandise exports to the US in FY25: \$87 billion) are at risk, the downside is likely to be material in

case the 50 per cent tariff rate is continued until the end of FY26," Nayar said.

Given this, India's exports to the US are likely to contract during the remainder of the fiscal. ICRA expects India's overall merchandise exports to decline somewhat in FY26 from the levels seen in FY25, and for the current account deficit to exceed 1 per cent of GDP, while remaining at moderate levels.

Merchandise trade deficit rose to \$68.5 billion (\$56.7 billion). Net services receipts increased to \$47.9 billion in Q1 from \$39.7 billion a year ago. Services exports have risen on a y-o-y basis across major categories such as business services and computer services, RBI said in a statement.

'India should aim to be the world's largest economy'

India has the potential to be the world's top economy if it can harness tailwinds such as its demographic dividend, macroeconomic stability, fiscal consolidation, digital revolution, financial sector resilience and inflation targeting framework, according to a former Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India, Michael Patra.

**ON THE RIGHT TRACK** The country's ambition should move beyond being the world's second-largest economy and aim to be the largest, Patra said at an event organised by Elara Securities, 'Elara India Dialogue Ashwamedh'.

"From a food-shortage economy to one of surplus, from inwardness and import substitution to outwardness and liberalisation — the transformation since independence has been remarkable," he said, adding "by the mid-2040s, India is projected to overtake the US to become the second largest economy. But our ambition need not stop there."

## Pass-through of repo cuts to lending, deposit rates has been strong: RBI

The pass-through of the cumulative 100 basis points (bps) cut in the repo rate during February 2025 to June 2025 to lending and deposit rates, especially for fresh deposits and loans, has been strong, according to RBI officials.

The weighted average lending rate (WALR) on fresh and outstanding rupee loans of scheduled commercial banks declined by 79 bps and 31 bps, respectively, per their assessment, published in the latest monthly bulletin.

The aforementioned development comes even as full transmission of the 100 bps repo rate cut has taken place in the case of loans linked to the external benchmark (repo rate)-linked lending rate (EBLR).

Loans linked to EBLR include home loans, vehicle loans, education loans, personal loans, mortgage loans, MSME loans etc.

**MCLR SLOWDOWN**

In the case of loans linked to the MCLR (marginal cost of funds-based lending rate) benchmark, the transmission has been relatively slower as it is referenced to factors such as a bank's cost of funds, operating costs, and CRR (cash reserve ratio).

For example, banks' MCLR (overnight) has declined to 7.8/8.15 per cent as on August 22, 2025, against 8.15/8.45 per cent as on August 23, 2024 — down about 35/30 bps.

Loans linked to MCLR in-

clude non-MSME (corporate) loans, agriculture loans, commercial dairy financing, gold loan (agri and non-agri), loans to SHGs and MFIs, advances against warehouse receipts, among others.

**DEPOSIT RATES**

On the deposit side, the weighted average domestic term deposit rates (WADTDTR) on fresh and outstanding deposits also moderated to 87 bps and 10 bps, respectively, according to RBI data.

On the other side of the spectrum is the perception that official interest rates may not fall further — which is expressed in bond yields remaining firm (a bullish steepener like scenario), where abundant overnight liquidity keeps short tenor rates abysmally low while long-end of the rate curve is

factoring in a no-further-cut interest rate regime and hardening, factoring in bond supplies."

Gurumurthy observed that hardening sovereign bond rates also influence corporate bond yields, which in turn have an impact on lending rates.

He noted that current bond yields are closer to where they were post the first rate cut (February 2025) and the subsequent 75 basis rate cuts have been unfactored.

**LOAN PRICING**

Venkatakrishnan Srinivasan, Managing Partner & Founder, Rockfort Fincap LLP, assessed that even after 100 bps of repo rate cuts and a liquidity-surplus environment, lending rates in the banking system have not softened to the extent expected.

"Banks are inherently slower in transmitting rate cuts, as loan pricing is linked not just to policy rates but also to their overall cost of funds, deposit structures, and internal balance sheet considerations," he said.

"That said, the benefit of lower rates has been relatively better for fresh borrowers, where banks have reduced rates more noticeably. Still, overall transmission remains much slower compared to the bond market, where yields adjust almost instantly to policy announcements, liquidity shifts, or global triggers," he added.

This time lag often leaves bank loan rates misaligned with prevailing market levels, particularly for top-rated corporates.

## RBI's forex reserves: US treasury securities cut, gold holdings up

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has cut its holding of US Treasury Securities by \$14.5 billion in the last one year even as it stocked up on gold in the backdrop of rising US Treasury yields, geopolitical and US tariff-related uncertainties.

The Central bank's holding of US Treasury Securities declined from \$241.9 billion as at June-end 2024, to \$227.4 billion as at June-end 2025, as per US Department of Treasury data.

The RBI's gold holding

rose to 879.59 metric tonnes as at March-end 2025, up 57.49 tonnes from 822.10 metric tonnes as at March-end 2024, per the latest Central bank data.

During the aforementioned period, the proportion of gold reserves in the foreign exchange reserves increased to 12 per cent from 8 per cent.

**DOLLAR VOLATILITY**

Shrisha Acharya, Vice President, Anand Rath Global Finance, observed that the RBI has strategically cut its US Treasury holdings by about \$15 billion, while simultaneously increasing its

gold reserves by nearly \$24 billion.

"Despite this shift, India's total foreign exchange reserves remain robust at \$690.7 billion. This realignment reflects a broader global trend of Central bank de-dollarisation, driven by geopolitical uncertainties, with gold increasingly preferred as a safe hedge against US debt risks, currency volatility, and inflation pressures," he said.

Acharya noted that the recent US tariff actions have further heightened the risk of dollar volatility, strengthening the case for diversification of the forex reserves.

## 'Deutsche Bank puts India retail banking biz up for sale'

Deutsche Bank is exploring the sale of its Indian retail banking assets and has invited bids from domestic and foreign lenders in the country, two sources told *Reuters*, making it the latest foreign bank to consider trimming its bets on India.

In March, CEO Christian Sewing said headcount will be cut by almost 2,000 people in 2025, with a "significant" reduction in branch numbers. In India, Deutsche wants to sell its retail banking business, which spans 17 branches, according to the

two sources with direct knowledge of the matter, who declined to be named as the discussions are private.

**'NO COMMENTS'**

A Deutsche Bank spokesperson said it does not "comment on rumours or market speculation".

The sources said Deutsche had set an August 29 deadline for non-binding bids from several banks for its India retail assets. Details of any potential bids received were not immediately clear.

Deutsche's retail banking revenue in India in the financial year to March 2025 stood at \$278.3 million, its disclosures show.

## IRDAI staffer held for 'embezzling' ₹5.3 crore

An Assistant Manager of the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has been arrested on the charges of forgery, cheating and misappropriation of funds to the tune of ₹5.30 crore.

The accused, Bhaskarabhatla Suryanarayana Sastry, an assistant manager in the general administration department, created and forged invoices, office notes, quotations and diverted IRDAI funds to his personal bank account and those of his family members.

**KIN INVOLVED?**

The accused, according to police, hatched a premeditated plan to divert the funds from IRDAI's processed

Indian GCCs recorded an overall workplace culture score of 82, according to Deloitte's India global capability centres (GCCs) Culture Sensing Report. The report analysed workplace culture by conducting AI-driven sentiment analysis on data shared by employees on social media.

Technology, media and communication GCCs led with a score of 83. Life sciences & healthcare and consumer businesses trailed at 82. Financial services, along with energy, resources and industrial GCCs, followed with a score of 81.

**CULTURE SCORES**

The report measured culture scores across five pillars of

Tech, media and communication GCCs led with 83 points. Life sciences, healthcare and consumer biz trailed at 82

empowerment and inclusion, ethics and sustainability, growth and learning, performance and results and agility and innovation. Interestingly, Indian GCCs performed impressively in the empowerment and ethics pillars, but lagged behind in innovation and agility.

Speaking to *businessline*, the study's author and Partner at Deloitte India Saurabh Dwivedi said, "Over the past few years, there has been much talk about GCCs moving up the value chain, going

from being just a back-end office to innovation hubs for the parent organisation. However, analysing the employee sentiments points out the innovation may not be percolating down to the employees," he said.

**LAGGARD INNOVATION**

Dwivedi points out that the laggard innovation could be due to GCCs having rigid protocols which hinder change. This perceived lack of implementation of new ideas may lead to potential delays and bureaucratic hurdles which may not be the right ecosystem that you need for innovation in the organisation, he said.

The financial services sector posted the lowest innovation score of 69. Dwivedi said, the sector showed an overwhelming sentiment of a strained work-life balance.

# China announces plans for SCO Development Bank

PTI, TIANJIN: Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi on Monday announced that the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) member states have decided to set up a Development Bank to increase the efficiency and social development of the region.

The approval to set up the bank, a Chinese proposal, came after 10 years of deliberations among the member countries, Wang said.

He added that the new bank will increase the efficiency and social development of the region. He, however, did not indicate any timeline to set up the bank.

The SCO will launch this important process, and there will be one more multilateral platform in the Euro-Asian region, he said.

It is a good thing to celebrate not only for the member states but also for

our region, Wang said. Chinese President Xi Jinping, in his inaugural address earlier, urged SCO member states to accelerate the creation of a development bank, considering the growing appeal of the 10-nation bloc.

China had been pushing the grouping to set up a development bank on the

lines of the New Development Bank (NDB) of the BRICS and the Asian Infrastructure Bank (AIIB), in which India is the second largest shareholder.

Both banks, based in China, which were initially regarded as competitors to the IMF, World Bank and the Asian Development Bank (ADB), are now

working with them with a co-financing pattern.

Wang said SCO has also approved the admission of Lao as a new SCO partner.

Also, the summit has decided to merge the observer states and dialogue partners into one unified state as the SCO partner. This is aimed at improving the efficiency of the organ-

isation, he said.

Founded in 2001 in Shanghai, the SCO now includes Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, China, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, India, Pakistan, Iran and Belarus. Afghanistan and Mongolia are observer states, and 14 other countries serve as dialogue partners.

The SCO has an extended family of 27, Wang said.

In another development, Pakistan and Armenia have agreed to establish diplomatic relations, shedding their differences, Wang said.

Wang said the leaders witnessed the unveiling of the four security centres - the SCO universal centre for countering security challenges and threats, the information security centre, the centre combating transnational crimes, and the SCO anti-drug centre.

## India reiterates Oppn to China's BRI at SCO conclave

PTI, TIANJIN: India on Monday refused to endorse China's ambitious Belt and Road initiative (BRI), becoming the only country in the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) not to support the connectivity project.

A declaration unveiled at the end of the SCO summit in this Chinese port city said Russia, Belarus, Iran, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Pakistan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan reaffirmed their support to the Chinese connectivity initiative. India has not endorsed the BRI in any previous SCO meetings and summits.

The declaration said the eight member nations noted the ongoing work on the joint implementation of this project, including efforts to align the development of the Eurasian Economic Union and the BRI.

## India-UK FTA boosts business confidence, UK Parliament told

PTI, LONDON: The India-UK Free Trade Agreement (FTA) signed between Prime Ministers Narendra Modi and Keir Starmer on July 24 will slash trade tariffs from 15 per cent to 3 per cent and boost business confidence in an increasingly volatile world, the British Parliament was told on Monday.

As members of Parliament returned to the House of Commons in London after the summer recess, UK Business and Trade Secretary Jonathan Reynolds tabled a statement to update MPs on the pre-ratification process underway before the trade deal can come into force.

The India-UK Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), as the FTA is officially known, must be ratified under the UK's Constitutional Reform and Governance Act 2010 (CRaG) for the requisite legislation to pave the way for the deal's implementation phase.

"This agreement drops the average Indian tariff on UK products from 15 per cent to 3 per cent, with tariff duties falling around 400 million pounds from entry into force, rising to 900 million pounds after staging," noted Reynolds in his Commons statement.

"It is expected to increase bilateral trade by 25.5 billion pounds, increase UK GDP by 4.8 billion pounds, and boost wages by 2.2 billion pounds every year. We

are showing the world that we stand for free, fair, and open trade. In an increasingly unstable and volatile world, this deal provides businesses with confidence as they grow and expand," he stated.

Reynolds, who negotiated the deal with Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal, highlighted how the India-UK CETA secures "unprecedented" preferential access to India's federal procurement market, locking in guaranteed market access for UK service suppliers, and making trade "quicker, cheaper, and easier" through improved customs and digital processes.

The Cabinet minister also informed Parliament about the formal commissioning of the Trade and Agriculture Commission (TAC) as well as the Food Standards Agency (FSA) and Food Standards Scotland (FSS) to provide independent advice for the government's report under Section 42 of the Agriculture Act 2020.

## EU to weigh abortion aid scheme after successful petition

AFP, BRUSSELS: The EU said Monday it will examine a petition calling for it to facilitate safe access to abortion for all European women, after the appeal collected more than one million signatures.

Liberalised across most of the 27-nation bloc, the right to end pregnancies remains severely restricted in some countries -- notably Malta and Poland.

As a consequence, more than 20 million women in the European Union do not have access to safe abortion care, women's rights campaigners say.

To change that, a coalition of women's rights groups last year launched "My Voice, My Choice", a campaign urging the EU to take action.

"In many countries in Europe abortion is not safe, it's not accessible, it's not free, and we want to provide every woman the possibility of having it," Federica Vinci, the campaign's coordinator for Italy, told AFP.

Rather than requiring changes in national laws, the petitioners asked Brussels to set up a financial mechanism to help liberal member states provide abortions to women from countries where it is not readily available.

The initiative secured more than one million signatures -- the minimum threshold required to force the European Commission to address it -- last December and was officially submitted on

Monday.

It is not legally binding, but the commission now has to issue a reply before March 2, 2026, outlining the actions it intends to take.

"The Commission will meet the organisers to discuss the initiative in detail in the coming weeks. A public hearing will then be organised by the European Parliament," the EU executive body said in a statement.

## Pope Leo meets LGBTQ+ advocate, pledges continuity with Francis' legacy

AP, VATICAN CITY: Pope Leo XIV met Monday with one of the most prominent advocates for greater LGBTQ+ inclusion in the Catholic Church and encouraged his ministry, just days before a planned Holy Year pilgrimage of LGBTQ+ Catholics to the Vatican in a sign of continued welcome in this new pontificate.

The Rev. James Martin, a New York-based Jesuit author and editor, said Leo told him he intended to continue Pope Francis' policy of LGBTQ+ accept-

ance in the church and encouraged him to keep up his advocacy.

"I heard the same message from Pope Leo that I heard from Pope Francis, which is the desire to welcome all people, including LGBTQ+ people," Martin told The Associated Press after the audience. "It was wonderful. It was very consoling and very encouraging and frankly a lot of fun."

The meeting, which lasted about half an hour, was officially announced by the Vatican in a sign

that Leo wanted it made public.

The audience was significant because it showed a strong sign of continuity with Francis, who, more than any of Leo's predecessors, worked to make the Catholic Church a more welcoming place for LGBTQ+ Catholics. From his 2013 quip, "Who am I to judge?" about a purportedly gay priest, to his decision to allow priests to bless same-sex couples, Francis distinguished himself with his message of welcome.
