IT sector's productivity engine gathers steam

REWRITING PLAYBOOK. Revenue per employee improves across tier-I firms as AI, better utilisation and tighter hiring boost efficiency

The June quarter highlighted a structural shift in India's IT services industry from a hiring-led growth model to a productivity-led one, with several tier-I firms improving revenue per employee (RPE) despite flat or declining headcount.

“The trend across Tier-I companies points to improving productivity rather than workforce expansion,” said Gaurav Vasu, Founder and CEO, UnearthInsight.

TCS reduced its headcount by 3.1 per cent year-on-year while increasing RPE by 6.1 per cent. Tech Mahindra's workforce shrank 1.2 per cent, but its RPE rose 7.4 per cent. "This reflects a combination of workforce rationalisation, higher utilisation and the early benefits of AI-led productivity improvements," Vasu said.

Infosys and HCLTech, meanwhile, managed to increase both headcount and productivity. Infosys expanded its workforce by 1.3 per cent and improved RPE by 1.5 per cent, while HCLTech added 0.3 per cent to its headcount and raised RPE by 2.6 per cent. “These companies are absorbing new talent without compromising productivity, reflecting stronger execution, better delivery optimisation and AI-driven efficiency gains,” Vasu added.

During Infosys' Q1FY27 earnings call, CEO and MD Salil Parekh attributed the company's improving revenue productivity to sustained efficiency gains.

"We recruited 20,000 college graduates last year and plan to recruit another 20,000 this year. Around 4,000 joined in the first quarter, while productivity improvements continue," he said.

TIER II: MIXED PICTURE

The trend is more varied among tier-II firms.

Emphasis increased head-count by 3.3 per cent while lifting RPE by 11.2 per cent, indicating strong demand

alongside efficient talent deployment.

In contrast, Wipro and LTTs expanded their workforce but saw RPE decline by 3.9 per cent and 8.4 per cent, respectively, suggesting hiring has outpaced revenue growth as they invest ahead of an anticipated recovery.

According to Sanketh Chengappa, Director-Professional Staffing and Business Head, Adecco India, RPE is increasingly evolving from a scale-driven metric to a productivity-driven one.

"The June quarter reflected stabilisation with pockets of improvement, particularly among tier-I firms that sustained revenue growth while maintaining discipline on headcount expansion," he said.

Among tier-I companies, higher RPE was driven by improved utilisation, tighter bench management, selective hiring, moderated fresher intake and a greater focus on high-value services such as AI, cloud, cybersecurity, data and digital transformation.

Tier-II companies, however, present a mixed picture.

Chengappa said niche players are gaining from capability-led growth strategies, while firms with greater exposure to discretionary spending and weaker pricing power have seen more modest productivity gains.

"In many cases, RPE improved because workforce expansion slowed, talent deployment became more efficient and companies focused on higher-margin services.

Selective hiring, attrition management and organisational restructuring also supported productivity despite modest revenue growth," he said.

Analysts stressed that companies with stronger demand visibility continue to recruit, particularly in AI, cloud and engineering, while maintaining productivity gains.

“Companies that have improved RPE are those that have become more disciplined about hiring while extracting greater value from their existing workforce. AI is automating routine work, improving developer productivity and streamlining delivery, but its financial impact is still evolving. For now, AI is acting more as a productivity multiplier than a standalone growth driver,” Vasu said.

Overall, the relationship between revenue growth and headcount growth is weakening. The industry is steadily moving from a scale-led model to one driven by productivity, where AI-assisted delivery, better utilisation and operational efficiency are becoming as important as workforce expansion.

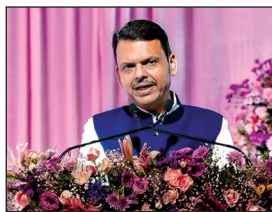

Ten dead in Bhiwandi building collapse during illegal repair work

Building was declared unsafe by civic body in 2020

PTI, THANE: At least 10 people were killed and three others injured after a four-storey residential building, tagged as 'dangerous' in 2020 by the local civic body and currently undergoing repairs illegally, collapsed in Bhiwandi town of Maharashtra's Thane district, officials said on Friday.

A portion of the Kohinoor Building in the Balaji Nagar area of the powerloom town, around 50km from Mumbai, came crashing down at 11.20 pm on Thursday, triggering a 19-hour-long multi-agency search and rescue operation that ended at around 7pm, they said.

Rescue workers from the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), Thane Disaster Response Force (TDRF), and municipal fire brigade personnel from Thane

city and Bhiwandi were involved in the operation as heavy machinery and sniffer dogs were deployed to look for survivors under the debris, said the officials of the district disaster management cell.

Shrikant Pardeshi, Assistant Municipal Commissioner and PRO, Bhiwandi Nizampur City Municipal Corporation (BNCMC), told PTI that ten people lost

their lives in the collapse, while three others were injured.

He said civic officials have approached the local Bhoiwada police for lodging a complaint against the contractor who carried out repairs in the building without obtaining permission from the BNCMC.

Senior Inspector Vikram Mohite of the Bhoiwada police said the process of

registering a case against the contractor was underway.

The collapsed structure comprised 48 rooms, 12 on each floor. Around 9 pm on Thursday, residents heard "loud cracking sounds" emanating from the building, an official said.

Fearing the worst, locals immediately helped evacuate many families to other locations. However, while some occupants were still making their way out, the 'B' wing of the building caved in, he said.

The officials said five of the deceased were identified as Shamim Shaikh (32), Ranjeet Singh (45), Miraj Rasul Shaikh (34), Santosh Kumar Pandey (42) and Shamim Ansari (30).

The BNCMC said it identified the building as "dangerous" in September 2020, and issued eviction notices on June 5 this year, subsequently disconnecting electricity and water supply. But despite that, the property owners initiated structural repair works without obtaining any permission from the civic body.

Hours before the crash, on July 30, 2026, a civic team led by an Assistant Municipal Commissioner visited the site and noticed structural instability. The team immediately evacuated around 40 residents and labourers working there, said the civic body.

Tahir Hussain, 4 others get life term in IB officer's murder

PTI, NEW DELHI: A Delhi court on Friday sentenced former AAP councillor Tahir Hussain and four co-convicts to life imprisonment for the murder of Intelligence Bureau officer Ankit Sharma during the 2020 Delhi riots, saying the case did not fall within the "rarest of rare" category warranting death penalty.

The prosecution had vehemently sought death penalty for all the five accused, saying they fell to the "level of being animals" while relentlessly assaulting Sharma.

While also convicting Nazim, Qasim, Javed and Anas, Additional Sessions Judge Praveen Singh said the prosecution failed to establish that they had such a violent disposition or criminal propensity that their continued existence, even in prison, would pose a menace to society.

"The final test that law re-

quires me to undertake before I conclude that this case invites capital punishment is whether the convicts are beyond redemption and there is no chance of reformation," the judge said, adding that the case did not fall under the rarest of rare category warranting imposition of death penalty.

Hussain was sentenced to six months' rigorous imprisonment under IPC Section 188, three years under Section 153A, two years

under Section 147, three years under Section 148, seven years under Section 365 and imprisonment for life under Section 302 IPC. All the sentences will run concurrently.

He was also fined Rs 1,000 under IPC Section 188, Rs 20,000 each under Sections 153A, 147 and 148, Rs 50,000 under Section 365 and Rs 5 lakh under Section 302, with default sentences prescribed for non-payment.

India keeping close watch on US tariffs

PTI, NEW DELHI: Days after the US Senate cleared a new bill that would authorise President Donald Trump to impose tariffs of up to 100 per cent on India, China and other major buyers of Russian oil and gas, New Delhi on Friday said it was closely monitoring the situation.

The bill will now be taken up by the House of Representatives for deliberation.

"On energy security, our position has been clarified and very well articulated on several occasions. It is something which is predicated on our national priorities and on securing the energy needs of our 1.4 billion people through diversified sources, which includes the US," External affairs ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said.

He was responding to a question on the US Senate clearing the bill by 86-12 vote.

"We remain engaged with relevant stakeholders in the US at various levels on this particular matter," Jaiswal said.

The Lindsey O Graham Sanctioning Russia and Iran Act of 2026 would impose primary and secondary sanctions against Russia and actors supporting its war in Ukraine.
